



New Covid Policy (Effective January 2022)

Students and EADC staff must adhere to the following guidelines established by CDC, SCPH, and Department of Social Services - Community Care Licensing:

1. All new and returning staff/students must be vaccinated and have had the booster shot within the timelines of their 2nd dose. A copy of vaccination status will be required to be in the office file prior to admission to the In-Person Day Program.
2. EADC will mandate a weekly (every Monday) PCR-nasal swab test to be conducted on EADC Campus for all direct care staff. For those students who are attending an In-Person Day Program, a permission form will be required by their authorized representative to test students on campus. If students or staff do not want to participate in the free weekly testing offered on campus, EADC will require that staff/students share their results weekly from an outside Covid-19 testing provider of their choice. **Positive test results MUST be shared with EADC as soon as possible for contact tracing purposes.**
3. If staff/student receives a positive Covid-19 test result and is asymptomatic, they must quarantine for 5 days and re-test prior to returning to In-Person Day Program. **If staff/student receives a positive Covid-19 result and is displaying symptoms, they are to quarantine for 10 days, self isolate and notify EADC ASAP and re-test 2 days prior to returning to day program.** Contact tracing will be implemented and SIRs will be sent to SARC, CCL and appropriate agencies.
4. Regardless of vaccination status, staff must wear masks at all times while on campus and follow proper CDC, DDS, Santa Clara Public Health guidelines. Students are highly encouraged to wear a mask at all times. However, we understand that some students may not tolerate wearing a mask. However, Evergreen ADC will encourage and/or reinforce wearing of masks while indoors or while in the van while on transport.
5. Adhere to the standard universal precautions as it relates to Covid-19 i.e. 6 ft. social distancing when appropriate, washing hands, covering coughs, and use of hand sanitizers.

Stay home if not feeling well.
